Topic: Auction Rate Preferred Securities — Current Maximum Rates Update

Details of the maximum annualized interest rates payable to preferred shareholders are provided below. Please note that because the auctions are held on a weekly or monthly basis, depending on each fund's particular structure, not all rates were effective as of 4/20/09.
